Application Steps and Key Dates for Year 7 entry in 2027

STEP

1

Arrange a Visit

It is essential that you visit the school. Contact our Admissions Secretary to arrange a visit - we recommend you do this when your child starts Year 5.

STEP

2

Register

Complete and submit a [THS Registration Form](#) and pay the registration fee of £120. Please note, applications are not registered until we have received both the form and payment.

The form can be viewed and downloaded from the School's website, or requested via our Admissions Secretary.

The registration fee can be paid by BACS, credit or debit card.

STEP

3

Take the THS Entrance Assessment

We will invite your child to sit the THS Entrance Assessment in the Summer Term of Year 5.

The THS Entrance Assessment involves a literacy (English) and numeracy (Maths) assessment. These are designed to help ensure an education at Thorpe Hall School is appropriate and that we can meet the needs of all our students.

THS Entrance Assessments for Year 7 2027 entry will take place on Saturday 6th June 9am - 11.30am

STEP

4

Offer

Subject to meeting our admissions criteria, we will offer you a place for your child and invite you to complete the relevant documentation for admission.

Offers will be made by Wednesday 24th June. We encourage early acceptance to secure a place

STEP

5

Contract and Deposit

To complete the application process and secure a place, parents/guardians are required to sign a contract with the school and pay a deposit. For entry into Senior School, a deposit of £1,000 per child is required. This deposit is returnable when you leave the school, provided the required notice has been given.

Applying for THS Grammar Plus for Year 7 entry in 2027

THS Grammar Plus is Thorpe Hall School's selective grammar stream with an annual intake at 11+. The next THS Grammar Plus intake is into Year 7 in September 2026 with entry via written examination. The THS Grammar Plus application steps and assessment, as outlined below, are required in addition, and essential for all THS Grammar Plus applicants.

1

Apply for THS Grammar Plus

Complete and submit a THS Grammar Plus Application Form.

You can apply at any time before the deadline, however all THS Grammar Plus applicants must have completed the THS Entrance Assessment (see Step 3 overleaf) before their THS Grammar Plus application can be processed.

Results and Offer
